_____ (initial) I understand and agree that at anytime in the future, it is determined that the above pipeline or utility is located on state lands and said lands are needed for a local, state or federal project, that I as the owner of the pipeline or utility will be responsible for its removal and/or relocation at my expense. If I refuse to timely remove or relocate the pipeline or utility within 45 days after receipt of written notice, the BLFWD can have the pipeline or utility removed or relocated and I will be responsible for all costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by the BLFWD in connection with such removal or relocation.

_____ (initial) I understand that in the event I sell this pipeline or utility, I will inform the purchaser of the existence of the permit and provide said purchaser with a copy of all documents related to this permit. I will also notify the BLFWD of any such sale.
